1. GENERAL

1.1 The legally adopted son / daughter of the employee will also be considered for admission.

1.2 The children of the deceased / retired employee will not be considered for admission unless the deceased employee's name is on the live roll of the scheme.

1.3 The candidates may also apply to Engineering for II BE under lateral entry scheme under the control of Director of Technical Education so as to be eligible to study in Government Engineering Colleges. However, they are free to join Government Colleges or Institute of Road and Transport Technology (GCE), Erode, under management quota if they get selected for both.

1.4 As a part of the regulation, candidates admitted in the second year BE Degree course under the Lateral Entry Scheme shall have to satisfy the conditions prescribed by the Anna University.

3. MINIMUM ELIGIBLE MARKS

Admission to the GCE ,Erode (IRTT) under reserved quota will be finalized strictly according to merit on the basis of the total marks obtained by them in all semesters reduced to 100.

The eligible candidates will be called for counseling in the order of merit and communal reservation, allotment of the branch chosen by the candidate will be made. The candidates will have the choice of selecting the course as per availability at the time of counseling.

35 % on 10 % of branch wise sanctioned strength is reserved for management quota.

5. COUNSELLING:

Counseling will be held at Government College of Engineering (IRTT), Erode 638 316 at the specified date and time.

Candidates will be called for counselling as per their rank and individual call letters will be sent by post. GCE will not held responsible for delay or non-receipt of call letters.

An intimation or call letters calling for counselling does not guarantee for admissions, since, more number of candidates are called than actual number of vacancy seats.

If the ranking of the candidate got altered due to retotalling / revaluation of marks, the candidate can attend the counselling as per the new mark and rank, though the call letter specifies different date, which is as per original marks.

Due to unavoidable circumstances, if the candidate is unable to attend the counselling on the specified date, their parent can attend the

counselling on behalf of the candidate and the parents' decision will be binding on the candidate.
